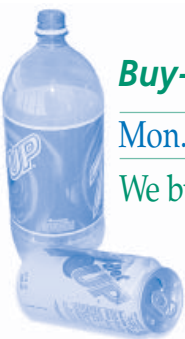
Blue Line Transfer & Recycling Center Update

Containers must be separated by material type to get the maximum value. For example, aluminum soda cans, plastic PETE soda or water bottles.

Spare the Air

Every Day is Spare the Air Day

South San Francisco Scavenger Company is committed to reducing air pollution. Since 2001 the company has used bio diesel fuel, an Ultra Low Sulfur diesel, in the company collection vehicles. The fuel is made from a mixture of diesel fuel and up to 50% soybean oil for a cleaner burning fuel.

The latest addition to the fleet is a CNG (compressed natural gas) truck for handling debris boxes. The CNG truck is used for, among other things, collecting food waste from the San Francisco International Airport and from food manufactures and other food related businesses. The food waste is sent to composting facility near Gilroy where it is turned into compost.

Cart Storage Reminder

Your carts for garbage, recycling and yard waste should be stored out of view from the street. Carts should be rolled out no more that 12 hours before collection and stored out of site no more than 12 hours after collection.
